

One of the most popular programmes on TV last Christmas was the latest Wallace and Gromit film- *Vengeance most Fowl*.

Behind the cute and creative style, there are some deep messages about good and evil, home and alienation, love, friendship, distraction and the limits of technology! And because it was so widely watched, we know too that it has meaning for our culture- not just in the

charm of stop-go animation, but also in the substance of the story. How do some of those themes help us to understand the love of God in Christ? What resonances might they have with the Gospel message?

On Tuesday mornings during advent, we are going to explore these very questions. We will begin with a short service of Holy Communion, and then (with a cup of coffee in our hands) we will watch a section of the film and discuss its message. We will be joined by our methodist friends, and all are welcome!

Prayer Shawl Ministry- a message from Joyce

Definition: Prayer shawl ministry combines the art of knitting or crocheting with prayer to create shawls that provide comfort and love. They are a tangible expression of care and support. Each stitch is infused with love and intention making the shawl a form of prayer".

This slightly formal definition does not do justice to the deep joy and emotional response that is displayed by those receiving a prayer shawl. The shawls are often, although not always, given to individuals during difficult times; those who have the gift of creativity give something special to a person who might be struggling. It is a physical reminder of the love and prayers surrounding them and a reminder that they are not forgotten or alone. They are not forgotten by us and they are not forgotten by God. The prayer shawls are accompanied with a personal prayer when being



delivered. A shawl always seems to arrive just when one is needed so thankyou to the knitters in the Loop. Patterns can be found on the website (and I have been asked this, so yes, you can watch to while knitting!).
