

FEBRUARY LOOP 2026

Lent

At the risk of 'banging on' (as my children would put it!), can I once again share with you my favourite seasonal preface:

*'For in these forty days
you lead us into the desert of repentance
that through a pilgrimage of prayer and discipline
we may grow in grace
and learn to be your people once again.
Through fasting, prayer and acts of service
you bring us back to your generous heart.
Through study of your holy word
you open our eyes to your presence in the world
and free our hands to welcome others
into the radiant splendour of your love.'*

The rhythm of fasting and feasting, so fundamental to the liturgical year, really matters. Especially in a society that loves the feast to just keep on going! This prayer, said before communion Sunday by Sunday during Lent, reminds us of the importance of the desert to our own formation and understanding of ourselves as God's people. May you enter into it wholeheartedly, and through doing so, may you (as the prayer says) have your eyes opened to the presence of God in the joys and the agonies of this world.

We begin Lent together on **Ash Wednesday (18th Feb)**, with a service at Bicton at 11.30am, followed by a soup lunch. Please do feel most welcome, and please let Wendy (01743 850237) know if you are staying for lunch- we would LOVE you to, but knowing numbers helps us not to waste food or have too little.

Encountering Jesus through 'The Chosen'

If you haven't already seen it, "The Chosen" is a highly successful, multi-season, historical drama based on the life of Jesus Christ, seen through the eyes of those who knew him. Its worldwide appeal has amassed 280 million viewers online, appealing to both those with and without Christian faith.

At its heart, it tells the story of Jesus, bringing the words of the Bible to life by providing a dramatic context for those words within Jesus' revolutionary life and teachings.

Across five Tuesday mornings during lent, we are going to explore something of the controversy Jesus would have stirred in his own time, and the increasing hostility he faced, that led to the events of Easter, and his death on the cross. Each Tuesday we will begin with a short service of Holy Communion, and then (with a cup of coffee in our hands) we will watch a section of "The

Chosen" and discuss its message. We will be joined by our Methodist friends, and all are welcome!
